| 4. Property Acquisition/Demolition | City of Waukesha | \$406,000 | \$463,500 |
| Acquisition and demolition of a commercial property located at 494 W. Main Street. | | | |

| Repair and re-grading of drainage ditch to include installation of storm sewers. | | | |
| 6. Lake Outlet Project | Town of Summit | \$506,000 | \$775,188 |
