



Town of Mukwonago Burning Permits

Town of Mukwonago residents wishing to burn brush, wood, or have a campfire, etc., **MUST** obtain a fire or bonfire permit in advance at the **MUKWONAGO VILLAGE POLICE DEPARTMENT**, Located at; 625 S. Rochester Street. The Mukwonago Village Police Department is open 24 hours a day. The burning permit is valid for one day and is issued only **after 7:00 A.M.** Phone number: 363-6435

RESTRICTIONS FOR FIRE PERMITS

- ✓ Wind must be less than nine (9) miles per hour at time of fire.
- ✓ Permit must be issued to landowner.
- ✓ Permits are good only on the day they are issued.
- ✓ Fire must never be left unattended.
- ✓ Water must be on hand and readily available
- ✓ It is illegal to burn tires, tire tubes, shingles or tar paper in the burn pile.
- ✓ Burn pile cannot be closer than 50 feet to any structure.

GUIDELINES FOR A BONFIRE PERMIT

- ✓ The pit or ring must not be larger than four (4) feet in diameter.
- ✓ Wind speed must be less than nine (9) miles per hour at time of bonfire.
- ✓ Bonfire must be out by midnight.
- ✓ The flames of the fire must not exceed five (5) feet in height
- ✓ No permits will be issued after dark
- ✓ Water supply must be on hand and readily available
- ✓ Permit will be issued only to landowner.
