## Town of Mukwonago Snow Removal Policy

In an effort to keep Town of Mukwonago roads safe and passable during the winter snow season, the Town is reviewing the snow removal policies and procedures. Additional policy changes may be required, as needed. This effort concerns the safety of the residents and their families, while keeping our Town roads drivable and as clear as possible.

### Snow Plowing Procedure

Type of Precip.	Actual Amount	Procedure
Snow Flurries	Trace to 1"	No plowing, salting or sanding.
Snow	1" to 4"	Plowing may begin with salting/sanding as required on the hills and intersections.
Snow	4" to 6"	Plowing will proceed to maintain at least one clear lane, salting/sanding as needed.
Snow	6" or greater	Plows will try to keep one lane passable and continue plowing as long as necessary. A "snow emergency" may be declared:

 Sec. 70-9 Snow emergency, parking, etc.

(c) *Notice of emergency.* The town chair, or other authorized officials, may proclaim the state of emergency through the press, radio or other public means of communication, and may designate and authorize police officers and snow removal personnel to inform the citizenry of the existence of the emergency.

(d) *Parking prohibited during emergency.* No person shall park any vehicle on a street, alley, public parking lot or the right-of-ways thereof during the period of a snow emergency or immediately thereafter until such street, alley or public parking lot has been cleared of snow.

Ice	Any Amount	Salt and sand roads and hills, as needed. If streets become too hazardous to travel, a "snow emergency" will be declared and roads will continue to be salted and sanded, as required.

The Town Contractor will be dispatched by the Town Police Department. A Town Board representative will be notified when the Contractor is called and may override/review the Police Department decision, if necessary.

Town Cul-de-sacs present a special problem for the snow removal crews. Plowing will be done to create a passable lane so that residents and emergency equipment will have access during the storm. Snow remaining in the center of the cul-de-sac will be removed periodically after an accumulation of snow, as long as there is a passable lane.

Town residents can help the plowing effort by not shoveling snow from driveways into the streets. Children should not play on or near the edges of roads or build forts near the Town streets for their own safety and the safety of fellow drivers that have to travel.
